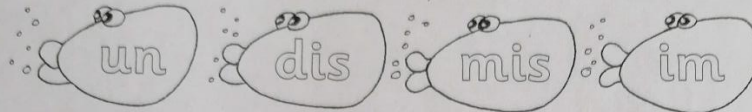
## Thursday:

## Prefixes

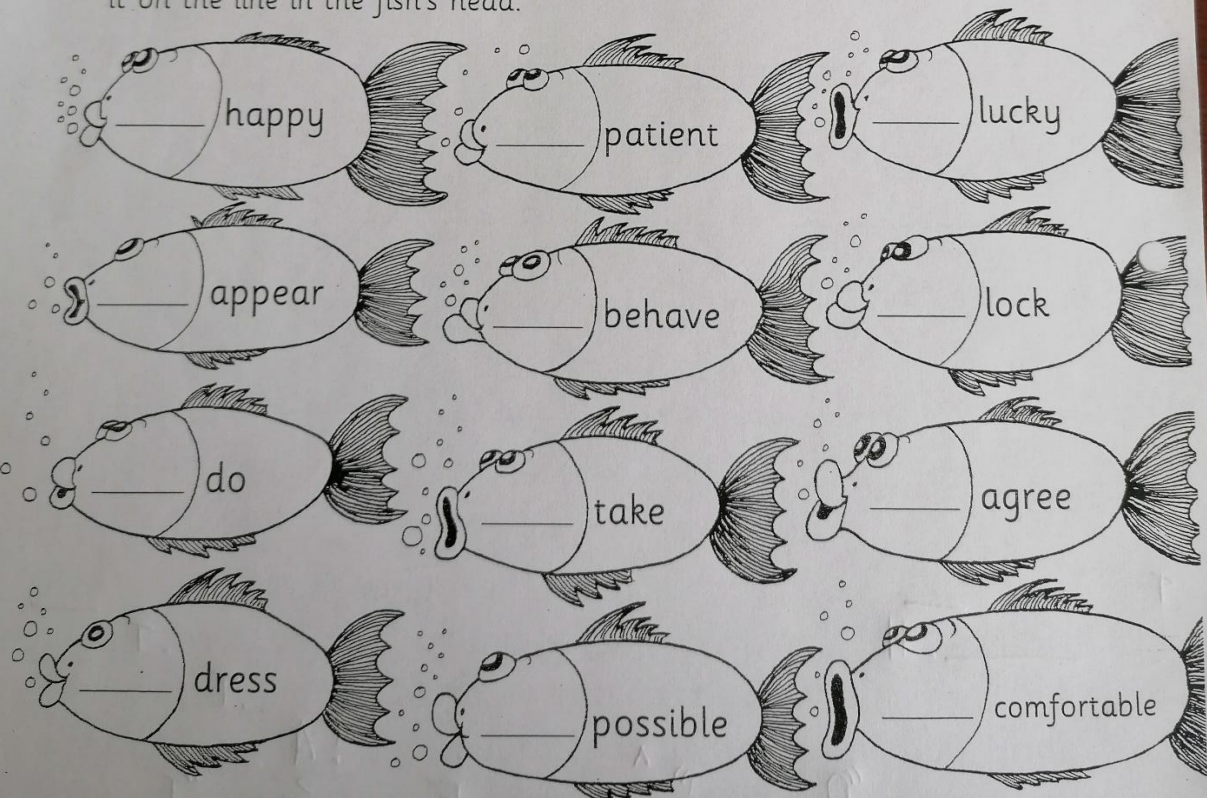
There are many prefixes, but these are four of the most useful ones.
